Sweetness Terms in Sparkling Wine

The common designations for the level of sweetness in sparkling wines is based upon the old French system and it can be confusing for consumers. If you want a *dry* wine (*i.e.*, very little sweetness), then counter-intuitively, do NOT select a wine with "Dry" or "Sec" in its name! Historically, sparkling wines were very sweet; the names of the levels were standardized early and only after the British palate changed to a dryer preference two centuries ago did truly dry wines become popular. As the terms "dry" and "sec" were already in use, new names were created. Here is a list of the official designations and the amount of sugar allowed in each:

Sparkling Wines by the Bottle

CHAMPAGNE (FRANCE)

Produced in the *Méthode Champenoise*, the king of wines is only Champagne if it is from the region of Champagne in France. These spiritually contemplative wines often spend years *sur lie* where the residual yeast in the bottle results in a wonderfully breadly nose. Champagne is always a blend of still wines, frequently made from Pinot Noir (a black grape) and Chardonnay.

SPANISH & CAVA

Produced in the *Méthode Champenoise*, Cava is made in 6 different regions in Spain, though 95% comes from Penedès. Typically fruitier than Champagne, Cavas are truly refreshing, frequently with notes of Lemon, Earth and Mushroom and a terrific acidity that makes pairing with nearly any food possible.

From Veneto in the northeast of Italy, Prosecco displays simple fruit flavors with an underlying bitterness. Prosecco is produced in the *Charmat* method in which the secondary fermentation which produces the effervescence is conducted in pressurized tanks.

Rosé Wines by the Bottle

Rosé wines are produced from black grapes in one of four ways: *Short term maceration*, *Saignée*, *Blending*, and *Direct Pressing*. As the juice of all but a small handful of black grape varieties is clear, the latter method produces the very palest of wines since the juice has very limited contact with the grape skins to extract color. Maceration, the act of allowing the juice to sit on the skins for a lengthier period of time, will produce more fully extracted and colorful wines. The *Saignée* method actually results in both a rosé wine and a more concentrated red wine by drawing off some of the juice after a short maceration for a rosé, while the remaining juice continues on the skins, producing a more concentrated red wine. Blending of red wine into white wine is mostly prohibited worldwide outside of Champagne.

Orange Wines by the Bottle

Orange wine is a unique and ancient category of wine. Made from nominally white grapes such as Pinot Gris, the wine making process is much nearer to that used in red wine production. Grapes are pressed and rather than draining off the free run juice, the wine sits on the skins (macerates) for anywhere from days to weeks, occasionally even fermenting on the skins. The wines thus pick up color and body during this maceration. Typically these wines are produced “naturally” with little intervention or stabilizing additives.

A native of Bordeaux, Cabernet Sauvignon is the noble red grape known around the world. With medium to high acidity, it pairs well with food. Typically, Cabernet Sauvignon wines will show notes of Black Currant, Plum, Black Cherry, Cedar, Vanilla and Bell Pepper. Medium to Full bodied.
